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IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

1. Please check carefully your name, date of birth, gender, category printed on the hall ticket. In case of any discrepancy, communicate to the TSICET-2021 help line centre, immediately.
2. Candidates should show the hall ticket at the entrance of the test centre and in the examination hall, failing which, the candidate will not be allowed to write the test. Candidate will be permitted to appear for the test only after their credentials are verified by the concerned officials.
3. The candidate shall carry into the examination hall (i) Black / Blue Ball Point Pen (ii) Hall Ticket (iii) Valid Original Photo Identification Cards (Aadhaar Card / College ID Card/ PAN Card/Passport/Voter ID and Driving License).
4. Candidate should reach the concerned test center one-and-half hour before the commencement of the exam, in order to capture the Photograph of the candidate. Candidates are advised to visit the Test Centre well in advance to get acquainted with the location of the Test Centre.
5. Candidates will not be permitted into the Examination Hall once the test commences (i.e.10:00 A.M. for morning session and 02:30 P.M. for afternoon session) and will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall till the END of the test (i.e.,12:30 P.M. for morning session and 05:00 P.M. for afternoon session).Candidates will not be allowed into the examination hall even if they are late by a MINUTE.
6. Carefully listen to the instructions given by the Invigilator and follow screen instruction after login. No clarifications or doubts related to the questions will be entertained during the test.
7. Candidates are advised to intimate the concerned authorities, in case of computer malfunctioning. The same will be rectified at the earliest possible.
8. Possession of Calculators, Mathematical/Log -Tables, Cell Phones, Digital Watches (all types),Large Spectacles, any other Electronic Gadgets and any papers (except Hall Ticket and Photo Identification Card) into the examination hall is strictly prohibited and can lead to debarment of the candidate.
9. Adoption of any kind of unfair means and any act of impersonation during the time of test will render the applicant liable for invalidation of candidate's examination. Further, the candidate will forfeit the claim of appearing for the test and will also make them liable for criminal action.
10. Ensure safety of your personal belongings. The test centre will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
11. Issue of Hall Ticket and by writing the test, does not guarantee admission for the candidate.
12. Blank papers will be provided for rough work in the examination hall. Candidates have to handover the rough sheets to the invigilator concerned after end of the examination.

COVID-19 SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATE

1. It is mandatory to wear a face mask properly at all times while the candidate is in the exam centre, preferably double mask.
2. **Candidates should maintain social distancing** while entering into/exit from the exam centre and also at all times while he/she is in the exam centre.
3. **Candidates should carry hand-sanitizer of up to 100 ml in transparent bottle, face mask, gloves and drinking water in transparent bottle** for personal use.
4. **Candidate should use hand sanitizer before entering examination hall.**
5. Candidate should not share personal items like mask, gloves, water bottle etc. with other candidates.
6. **Candidates with high temperature or other symptoms of COVID-19 will not be permitted to enter the examination centre and take examination.**
