- 1. Candidate must carry an original photo identity card having the same Date of Birth (including Date, Month & Year) as printed on the Admission Certificate
- 2. If photo identity card does not have the same Date of Birth (including Date, Month & Year) then the candidate must carry an additional certificate (in original) as proof of their Date of Birth.
- 3. In case of mismatch in the Date of Birth mentioned in the Admission Certificate and photo ID/Certificate brought in support of Date of Birth, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 4. Candidates must ensure that they do not appear in Paper II Examination of JE 2022 more than once. Otherwise candidature of such candidates would be cancelled and they would be debarred from future examinations of the Commission for a period of three years.
- 5. In Paper-II for General Engineering, the candidate will be required to attempt only the part as per option given in the application form filled by the candidate. In other words, the candidates appearing for the post of Junior Engineer (Civil), Junior Engineer (Quantity Surveying & Contracts) are required to attempt Part-A (Civil & Structural) of and Paper II and the candidates appearing for the post of Junior Engineer (Electrical) are required to attempt Part-B (Electrical) and the candidates appearing for the post of Junior Engineer (Mechanical) are required to attempt Part-I failing which their candidature will be rejected.
- 6. Candidates are allowed to bring their own Slide-Rule, Calculator, Logarithm Table and Steam Table for Paper-II.
- 7. The Paper-II will have to be written either in Hindi or in English. Part paper written in Hindi and part in English will be awarded zero marks.
- 8. In Paper-II, candidates must write their correct Roll Number and Subject at the <u>prescribed places on the cover page of the Answer Book</u>. Candidates must also affix signature and Left-hand Thumb Impression in the relevant columns in the Answer Book. Answer Books not bearing Roll Number, Subject, Signature and Left-hand Thumb Impression will not be evaluated and such candidates shall be awarded zero marks.
- 9. Candidates are strictly advised not to write any personal identity e.g. name, roll number, mobile number, address, etc inside the Answer Book (Paper-II). The candidates who fail to adhere to these instructions will be awarded zero marks.

#### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

- Candidate must carry original photo identity card having Date of Birth as printed on the Admission Certificate.
   If the photo identity card does not have the Date of Birth then the candidate must carry an additional certificate in original as proof of their Date of Birth.
   In case of mismatch in the Date of Birth mentioned in the Admission Certificate and Photo ID/ the Certificate brought in support of Date of Birth, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- Paper II will have to be written either in Hindi or in English. Part Paper written in Hindi and part in English will be awarded zero marks. Candidates are allowed to bring their own Slide-Rule, Calculator, Logarithm Table and Steam Table for Paper-II.
- 3. In Paper II, Candidates must write their correct Roll Number at the prescribed places on the cover page of the Answer Book. Candidates must also affix Signature and Left Hand Thumb Impression in the relevant columns in the Answer Book. Answer Books not bearing Roll Number, Signature and Left Hand Thumb Impression will be awarded Zero Marks.
- 4. Candidates are strictly advised not to write any personal identity, e.g. Name, Roll No., Mobile No., Address etc. inside the Answer Book (Paper II). The candidates who fail to adhere to these instructions will be awarded zero marks even if marks are awarded during the evaluation process.
- 5. Report to the Centre Supervisor at 08.30 AM. The entry of the Candidates inside the venue will ONLY be allowed between 08.30 AM and 09.30 AM. The Entry Gate of the Venue will be closed at 09.30 AM. No candidate shall be allowed entry after 09.30 AM.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE CANDIDATES

- 1. Candidates should invariably bring the following at the time of reporting for the examination:
  - (a) Admission Certificate
  - (b) Two copies of their latest coloured passport size photograph (3 cm x 3.5 cm).
  - (c) At least one valid photo bearing identity proof in ORIGINAL with clear photograph (Eligible photo identity proofs such as 1. Passport, 2. Aadhaar Card/Print out of e-Aadhaar, 3. Driving License, 4. Service ID Card issued to employees by Central Govt./State Govt./ PSUs, 5. ID Card issued by University/College/School6. Voter's ID Card, 7. PAN Card, 8. Ex-Servicemen Discharge Book issued by Ministry of Defence, 9. Any other Photo Identity Proof issued by Central Govt./ State Govt.).
  - (d) If the Photo Identity Card does not contain the complete Date of Birth, then the candidate must carry an additional original document having the Date of Birth as printed on the Admission Certificate(e.g. Admit Card/ Pass Certificate/ Marks Sheet of 10<sup>th</sup> Class issued only by CBSE/ ICSE/ State Boards; Birth Certificate, Category Certificate etc. issued only by Central Govt. / State Govt. / PSUs). In case of a mismatch in the Date of Birth mentioned in the Admission Certificate and Photo ID Proof/ the Certificate brought in support of Date of Birth, the candidate will not be allowed to appear in the examination.
  - (e) Pen/Pencil
  - (f) Face mask.
  - (g) Hand sanitizer (Small bottle).
  - (h) Transparent water bottle.
- No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination Venue before the completion of the examination time for any reason without permission. Once a candidate leaves the venue without the permission of the exam functionaries, he/she shall not be allowed to re-enter the examination Venue and his/her candidature shall be cancelled.
- Candidates shall be permitted to appear in the exam only at the venue as specified in the Admission Certificate.
- Candidates are advised to visit the exam venue at least one day in advance so that they can reach the examination venue on the date of exam in time.

- Candidature of candidates is purely provisional. It is advised that candidates should satisfy themselves that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions. If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not fulfil any of the eligibility conditions, his/her candidature shall be cancelled.
- 6. Prohibited items such as books, paper chits, magazines, electronic gadgets (mobile phones, Bluetooth devices, head phones, pen cameras/ buttonhole/ spy cameras, scanner, storage devices etc) are strictly not allowed in the examination Venue. If any such item is found in the possession of a candidate in the examination hall, his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled and legal/criminal proceedings could be initiated against him/her. He/she would also be liable to be debarred from appearing in future examinations of the Commission as per extant rules.
- 7. Candidates are advised not to bring bags and prohibited items into the examination venue. In case they bring any such item, they would have to make their own arrangements for safe custody of such items. The Commission will not be liable to make any arrangement for safe custody of any such item.
- Candidate should ensure that they do not indulge in any unfair means and shall also not talk to each other after commencement of the exam and during its entire duration.
- Candidate must strictly abide by the instructions given by the Exam Functionaries (Centre Supervisor / Invigilator, etc).
- Candidate should ensure that they provide clear Left Thumb Impression (LTI), Certification Statement in their running handwriting and signature on Commission's Copy of Admission Certificate.
- 11. If any candidate is found obstructing the conduct of the examination or creating disturbances at the examination venue, his/her candidature shall be summarily cancelled. Such candidate shall also be liable to be debarred from future examinations of the Commission and legal/criminal proceedings could be initiated against him/her. It may be noted that no reexamination would be conducted if it is found that the examination was disrupted on account of instigation by the candidates.
- Candidates are advised to report to the concerned Regional Office/ Commission, in case they
  notice any irregularity during conduct of examination. The identity of such candidates will be
  kept confidential.
- Eligible PwD candidates with Benchmark Disabilities are entitled for compensatory time of 20 minutes per hour and assistance of scribe in terms of Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) O.M. No.34-02/2015-DD.III dated 29.08.2018.
- 14. Candidates opting for own scribe, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking the examination. Such candidates shall be required to submit details of the own scribe in proforma at Annexure-II of the Notice of Examination. In addition, the scribe has to produce a valid ID proof (as per list given at Para-3) in original. A photocopy of the ID proof of the scribe signed by the candidate as well as the scribe is required to be submitted along with proforma at Annexure-II.
- 15. Scribe arranged by the PwD candidate should not be a candidate of this examination otherwise candidatures of both the candidates will be cancelled.
- 16. If any candidate is found in inebriated state that candidate will not be allowed entry to the venue.
- 17. In case of any doubt or clarification, the candidates are advised to contact the concerned Regional Office of the Commission personally or through the Helpline Numbers as indicated in the Admission Certificate.
